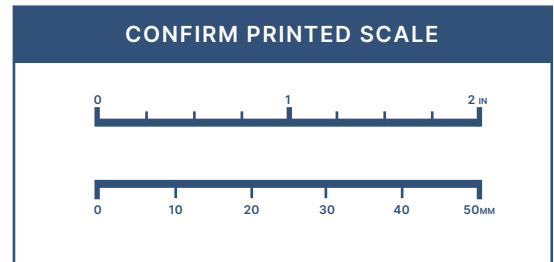


RING SIZER GUIDE

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE?

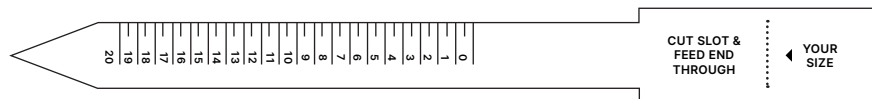
Print this page on standard 8.5 × 11-inch paper with a page scaling set to "100%" in your print settings. After printing, use a ruler to verify the size of the printed paper in the designated box below.

Measure the bar to ensure it's printed exactly 2 in (50mm) long.
The ring size will not be accurate if the measurement is not correct.



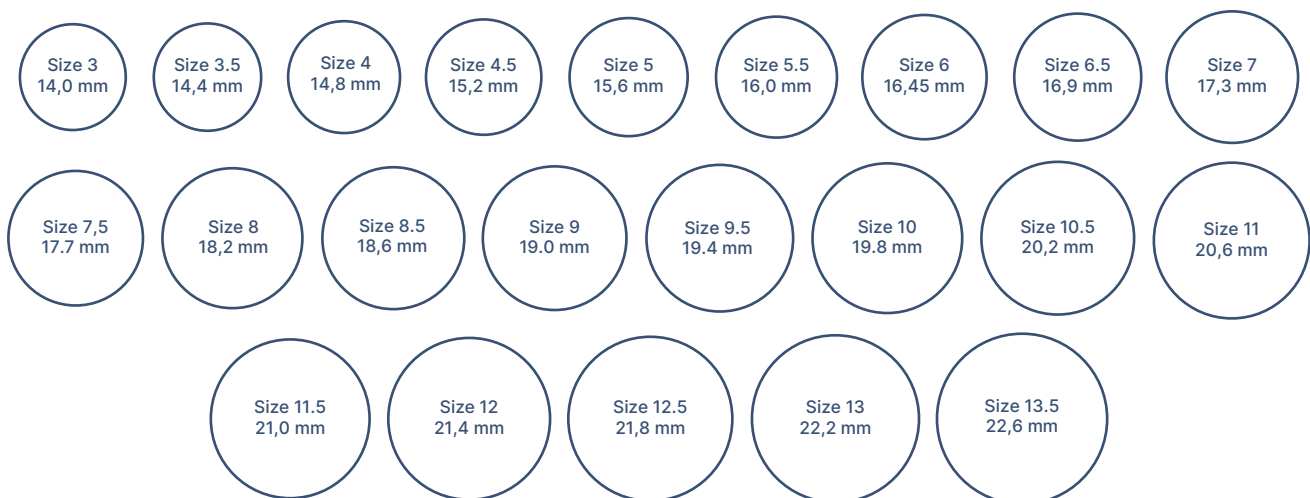
METHOD 1: PRINT A RING SIZER

1. Take a pair of scissors and cut out the ring sizer below. Cut a slit where it says "Your Size".
2. Slide the end of the sizer into the slit and **wrap the sizer snugly around your finger**. Make sure that it's comfortable and not too tight.
3. Read the number at the slit where it says "Your Size". This is your ring size.



METHOD 2: MEASURE AN EXISTING RING

1. Take a ring that fits comfortably on the finger you are buying the ring for.
2. Put it on top of the circles in the chart on the right. Make sure the inside of the ring lines up with the outside edge of the circle.



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
